

The tenor **Angelo Fiore** will perform as a soloist with the RTS Symphony Orchestra on the occasion of the "Music Night". Mr. Fiore is originally from Sicilia and graduated from the Luigi Carubini Conservatory in Florence. He attended master classes at the Maggio Fiorentino Theater in Florence and at the Cubec Academy with Mirela Freni in Mantova.

He is the winner of numerous solo singing competitions, among which are "Verdi" International Competition in Salsomaggiore Terme (Parma) and "Tita Rufo" where he won after making his debut as Duke of Mantova.

As part of the Luciano Pavarotti Foundation, he has performed at numerous concerts in theaters, including the "City Center" in New York, "Teatro Dal Verme" in Milan and "Teatro Grande" in Brescia.

He has performed the role of Calaf ("Turandot") and Duke of Mantova ("Rigoletto") at the "Puccini Festival" in Torre del Lago. He was Cassio ("Othello") at the Carlo Felice Theater in Genoa, directed by Andrea Batistoni and David Levermore. He was Pinkerton Junior ("Junior Butterfly") at the "Puccini Festival" in Torre del Lago, in a contemporary opera composed by Shigayaki Segusa, which also will be presented to the audience in Japan. He was Alfredo ("Traviata") at the "Teatro Goldoni" in Livorno and Duke of Mantova at the Musical Trapanese open-air theater.

He recently participated in the play "Boemi" at the Lithuanian National Opera Theater. He played Arigo in the opera "Sicilian Evening" at the "Gut Immling Oper Festival", and in the same role he appeared in a new production of this opera at the "Bayerische Staatsoper" in Munich, directed by Omer Velber.

This year he made his debut as Ernani ("Ernani") at the "Teatro alla Scala" in Milan, where he also appeared in the plays "Traviata" and "Robbers", which he will perform in Finland, at the "Savonlinna" festival.
